





point was that traditionally prescribed medicines are bad for you and there is a cheaper, better cure. I learned that eating an apple will stop the pain from acid reflux but only treats the symptoms, not the cause. To treat the cause will cost \$19.99 (now probably \$49.99). What a deal!

I share that story because it illustrates a major reason why I believe we are in the mess we are today-spiritually, culturally and nationally. I believe it is because we are busy eating apples, instead of dealing with the root problems. In fact, I wonder if we even know what the real problem is so that we can deal with it.

Psalm 11:3 says, "When the foundations are being destroyed, what can the righteous do?" As Christians we are kept busier than ever fighting battles on every hand-marriage, family, abortion, socialism, individual freedoms, etc., but we do not seem to be making any headway. In fact it appears that we are losing ground. Why is this so if the Lord is on our side? Could it be that the spiritual foundation of our nation has been eroded to the point that it is in danger of

Maybe it is because the proverbial boy has taken his finger out of the spiritual dike and the dike collapsing. It started with a little leak. It was left unattended and people became desensitized to it and came to think it acceptable and then normal. They even enjoyed the extra water flowing through the dike although-they had to build more dikes (laws) to protect their homes and cities.




