





For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16.

This is arguably the most well known verse in the Bible. It stresses the good news of God's love for the us, who have sinned against Him. Furthermore it reveals to us that God's love is active.
