



When my wife and I lived in Indiana, we lived near Ball State University and had the opportunity to host foreign students in our home. It was a great experience.

I remember one student from Africa whose religious beliefs did not allow him to eat pork. He didn't understand why the popular meat sandwich would be called a hamburger if it was not made out of ham. We could not convince him that a hamburger was made out of beef.

Though his resistance to eating a hamburger was based on a false assumption, my family and I respected his right to not eat hamburgers. We still ate them and he did not resent it when we did. But we always had something else that he could eat and not violate his own conscience.

When in college, many of the football games were Friday night. As a team, we always ate a pre-game meal together. The main course was a baked potato without butter, and steak. The problem was that many on the team were Roman Catholic, and at that time, they did not eat meat on Friday. The compromise was that those who did not want to eat the steak because of their religious beliefs could order fish instead. But they did not stop serving steak because some did not eat it. Nor was it considered a crime to eat steak in front of those who were Catholic?

But, it seems, times have changed. A middle school in Lewiston, Maine, is no longer serving ham because Muslim students object. In fact, a student is being charged with a "hate crime" for placing a ham sandwich on the table among Muslim students. So why do we show this kind of partiality to Muslims and not Catholics or Hindus or Jews, etc.? It isn't fair, is it?

But God, on the other hand, does not show partiality or favoritism. He is "no respecter of persons" (Acts 10:34). So every body is treated the same, no matter what their beliefs are or skin color is. That means that if you sin, you die, and therefore we all die, because we have all sinned (Romans 3:23). But if you accept God's forgiveness through Jesus Christ you will live (Acts 16:31). There is no favoritism. That means the thief on the cross who believed in Jesus can be saved and the high priest who rejected Jesus is lost. It also means your destiny is determined by your choice.There are no exceptions. I urge you to choose life— choose Jesus.




