

Frequently I hear someone say, "I was really lucky," or "This is my lucky day," or some such thing. But as a believer in Jesus Christ and in the sovereignty of God the Father, this idea of attributing circumstances in my life to luck has raised some real concerns for me.

First of all, it is expressing faith in some kind of fate, like there is an impersonal force working things out behind the scenes in my life. Sort of like in the Star Wars movies when someone says, "the Force be with you." But to me, this idea is completely contrary to a personal, all-powerful, God who 'works all things together for good" in my life (Romans 8:28). Therefore, to attribute events in my life as mere luck, seems to me to make the sovereign God merely a subordinate God to the god of fate, and thus not really a God at all.

Secondly, Romans 1:21 says, "For although they knew God, they neither glorified him as God nor gave thanks to him, but their thinking became futile and their foolish hearts were darkened." I now realize that if I attribute happenings in my life to fate (or luck) I rob God of glory and give credit (or thanks) to "fate" rather than God. And if I do so, it reveals the fact that I am not really conscious of God's continual presence their lives.

Now I am sure that to attribute happenings to luck is not necessarily a conscience thing. It is just so commonplace that for most people it has become just an expression. So really, it is no big deal. Right?

Actually, I think it is a bigger deal than we think. Besides, it's "the little foxes that spoil the vine" (Song of Solomon 2:15). Just think about it. Every time we attribute something to luck, we are committing the sin of omission, which is, not glorifying God when we should, as well as not giving thanks to God, although He is the one who deserves it. The result is that our thinking becomes more and more worldly, that is, not recognizing God's involvement in our lives. And, possibly even worse, our conscience becomes seared so that these things don't even bother us anymore.

Continuing this train of thought to its conclusion over a period of time, little concessions in our Christian faith will result in living much like the world. It will become hard to tell the difference between a Jesus follower and one who is not. Come to think of it, isn't that where we are now?




