Black River Falls on July 5, 2022 at 6:00 P.M. Alder-
persons Mathews, Olson, Busse, Gearing-Lancaster,
Wussow, Brown, and Ammann were present. Alderper-
son Rave was absent. Mayor J. Eddy presided.
It was moved by Alderperson Busse, seconded by
Alderperson Gearing-Lancaster, to dispense with the
reading of the minutes of the June 15, 2022 Special
Common Council meeting. Motion carried.
CITIZENS IN ATTENDANCE
There were no citizens in attendance.
COMMITTEE REPORTS
It was moved by Alderperson Ammann, seconded
by Alderperson Olson, to place on file the minutes of
the June 14, 2022 Joint Review Board meeting. Mo-
tion carried.
It was moved by Alderperson Busse, seconded by
Alderperson Wussow, to place on file the minutes of
the June 27, 2022 Utility Commission meeting. Motion
Carried.
It was moved by Alderperson Ammann, seconded
by Alderperson Brown, to approve the S&P Global Rat-
ing engagement letter for analytic review and issuance
of credit rating. Motion carried.
It was moved by Alderperson Mathews, seconded
by Alderperson Gearing-Lancaster, to approve the ap-
plication for a Temporary Class B Beer and Class B
Wine (Picnic) License for the Jackson County Ag So-
ciety for the Jackson County Fair August 2-7, 2022 at
388 Melrose Street (The Fair Park). Motion carried.
It was moved by Alderperson Ammann, seconded
by Alderperson Wussow, to approve the applications
for Liquor Operator's Licenses. Motion carried (6-0-1)
with Alderperson Mathews abstaining.
There was discussion on a proposed amendment
to Section 8.05 of the Code of Ordinances including
whether or not displays and merchandise should be re-
moved after hours and if sign/message boards would
be affected as they are not typically within 3 feet of the
business. There was unanimous consent to recom-
mend the Black River Falls Downtown Association dis-
cuss the proposed changes to Section 8.05 and pro-
vide their recommendations to the Council and to have
the Chief of Police look at the sign/message board is-
sue and get back to the Council.
There was discussion on a proposed amendment
to Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances to create Sec-
tion 2.07 for meetings by telephone or other commu-
nication technology. There was unanimous consent to
move forward with the amendment with changes to al-
low for full compensation for up to two (2) virtual meet-
ings per calendar year and then 50% compensation for
any additional virtual meetings.
There was discussion on a proposal to vacate a 15-
foot public walkway on Chestnut Street in the Borufka's
Addition. There was unanimous consent to move for-
ward with the process to vacate this public walkway.
It was moved by Alderperson Mathews, seconded
by Alderperson Wussow to adjourn. Motion Carried at
6:34 pm.
