December 19, 2022

The Regular Session of the Jackson County Board of Supervisors was called to order at 5:30 P.M., on Monday, December 19, 2022, at the Jackson County Courthouse in the County Board Room by Chairman Amo. County Clerk, Cindy Altman, took roll call with 17 members present, 1 excused (Supervisor Jensen) and 1 vacant (District 4). The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Chairman Amo asked for confirmation of the appointment of Daryl Boe to Supervisory District 4. Supervisor Chamberlain made a motion to confirm the appointment to District 4 and this was seconded by Supervisor Hart. Voice vote was taken with 17 present voting Aye. Supervisor Boe was sworn into office.

Chairman Amo asked if there were any corrections or additions to the minutes of the previous meeting. Supervisor Rolbiecki made a motion to approve the minutes. This was seconded by Supervisor Peloquin. Voice vote was taken with 18 present voting Aye.

VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may request to vote an absentee ballot to their municipal clerk. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen, who will be 18 years of age or older on Election Day, who has resided in the ward or municipality where he or she wishes to vote for at least 28 consecutive days before the election. The elector must also be registered in order to receive an absentee ballot. Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued.

You may make request for an absentee ballot in writing, via email, fax or online at MyVote.wi.gov

You will need to send a copy of your Photo ID with your request if the clerk's office does not have it on file. Your request must list your voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different, and your signature.
