**FIREWORKS REGULA-
TION ORDINANCE
NOTICE IS HEREBY
GIVEN** that the Town
Board of the Town of
Cleveland, Jackson
County, Wisconsin, ad-
opted Ordinance No.
2026-10, Fireworks Regu-
lation Ordinance, on May
12, 2026.

The ordinance regu-
lates the possession,
use, and discharge of
fireworks within the Town
of Cleveland. The ordi-
nance establishes permit
requirements, limited ex-
ceptions for certain dates
and times, rural safety
restrictions, public safety
requirements, nuisance
provisions, permit proce-
dures, enforcement au-
thority, and penalties for
violations.

The ordinance pro-
vides forfeitures for viola-
tions and authorizes the
seizure of fireworks used
in violation of the ordi-
nance.

The full text of Ordi-
nance No. 2026-10 may
be obtained from the
Town Clerk upon request
or from the website www.
townofcleveland.org.

This ordinance shall
take effect the day after
publication as provided by
Wisconsin Stat. § 60.80.
