It was moved by Alderperson Busse, seconded by Alderperson Olson, to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the February 15, 2023 Special Common Council meeting and approve as presented. Motion carried.

There were 6 citizens in attendance for agenda items.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

It was moved by Alderperson Ammann seconded by Alderperson Gearing-Lancaster, to place on file the minutes of the February 3, 2023 Special Utility Commission meeting. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderperson Olson, seconded by Alderperson Busse, to place on file the minutes of the February 20, 2023 Utility Commission meeting. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderperson Busse, seconded by Alderperson Olson, to approve Application for Payment #6 from Badger Environmental for River-view Drive Utility Extension (TID #8) in the amount of \$48,039.60. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderperson Ammann, seconded by Alderperson Gearing-Lancaster, to approve the applications for

Liquor Operators Licenses as presented. Motion carried.

There were no objections to having the City Administrator bring a resolution back to the Council to authorize the City Administrator to approve applications for Liquor Operators Licenses with the stipulation to bring any applications that the Police Department has concerns with to the Council.

Two Letters of interest were received for the vacant First Ward Alderperson position. Current Plan Commission member Steve Aldach was present, shared his community involvement which included previously serving 6 years on the Jackson County Board of Supervisors and stated he believed the top priorities of the city right now should be downtown safety, streets, growth, expansion of businesses, and childcare. Mayor Eddy explained committee participation. Former First Ward Alderperson Erin Rave was present and stated she believed the top priorities of the city right now should be tourism and attracting more people to the community. Mayor Eddy explained committee participation.

Alderpersons attending in person cast paper ballots and Alderpersons participating via Zoom cast ballots using the chat feature to cast their votes to appoint a First Ward Alderperson. The voting was then read aloud. Erin Rave received 4 votes and Steve Aldach received 3 votes. Erin Rave was appointed First Ward Alderperson, was sworn in, and took her place on the Council for the remainder of the meeting.

A petition from Reed Richardson to vacate part of the Sandbergen Heights Plat was presented to the Council. Mr. Richardson addressed the Council providing history on the land, the process he used to get the petition drafted, the creation of the plat, the land being platted for over 40 years with no improvements, the small size of the lots in the plat, his desire not to get in to the subdivision business, and his desire to vacate the plat in order to sell the property as one lot which would be more marketable. The City Administrator advised the Council that the City Attorney's advice is to admit service of the petition and then not file any answer so that Reed can get a default judgment vacating that portion of the plat.

It was moved by Alderperson Olson, seconded by Alderperson Brown, to purchase eleven (11) new office chairs from Madison Seating for the Council chambers at a cost not to exceed \$4,665.21. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderperson Olson, seconded by Alderperson Gearing-Lancaster, to adjourn. Motion carried at 6:37 pm.

CITY OF BLACK RIVER FALLS VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT
