Black River Falls Municipal Utilities (BRFMU) is seeking sealed bids from qualified bidders for the procurement of WWTP sludge hauling services. Bids will be received at the Black River Falls Municipal Utilities at 349 South McKinley Street, Black River Falls, WI 54615, until 3:00 p.m. local prevailing time on October 24, 2023, at which time they will be publically opened and read aloud.

Responsible bidders must have the ability to provide off-site liquid sludge storage with a capacity of 550,000 gallons, annually, in a Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources approved storage facility. Bidder will be responsible for procuring sites and obtaining any permits for off-site land application, in accordance with applicable federal, state, and local laws. Responsible bidders must also possess the knowledge, trucks, and equipment necessary to accommodate such storage and off-site land application.
