Brief Facility Description
and Summary of Proposed
Changes: The Hatfield
Sanitary District treats
domestic waste- water.
The system is comprised
of 3 stabilization ponds
operated on a fill and draw
basis with effluent being
discharged in the spring
and fall. The wastewater
enters the primary pond
where it is detained and
treated through natural
biological reduction, and
then flows to the second-
ary ponds for holding and
polishing. Phosphorus
removal is via alum addi-
tion. The treated effluent
from the secondary ponds
enters an outfall sewer
which discharges to the
Black River. The annual av-
erage influent design flow
of the facility is 0.057 million
gallons per day (MGD), and
the actual annual average
influent treated in 2022 was
0.011 MGD. No major op-
erational changes have oc-
curred since the last permit
issuance. Major effluent
monitoring changes for this
permit issuance include
lower effluent phosphorus
interim limits associated
with an approved multi-
discharger variance for
phosphorus (MDV) and
compliance schedules to
comply with s. 283.16, is.
Stats. requirements for
phosphorus, and annual
nitrogen series monitoring.

Department has deter-

(MDV) in accordance with

MDV provides a time ex-
tension for the permittee
to comply with the final
water quality based effluent
limits for phosphorus while
contributing funds towards
nonpoint pollution control
projects. Comments on
this determination are
requested and additional
supporting documentation
and data are available upon
request.
