Town of Albion will receive sealed Bids for the 2022-2023 Cloverdale Rd – TRIS Road Reconditioning Project **at the Town of Albion Town Hall, N5740 State Hwy 54, Black River Falls, WI 54615** at the time and date stated above, at which time, all submitted Bids shall be publicly opened and read aloud.

The Work for which Bids are asked includes the following:

CONTRACT 1 – Road Reconditioning for approximately 1.0-mile Rural Road Section. Proposed work consists of general grading, new road base, ditching, install new road culverts, install new driveway culverts, erosion control and restoration. Proposed road base consists of 6” crushed aggerate base, 10” breaker run over select areas. New road culverts to be installed by end of 2022. Final completion is set for spring of 2023.

CONTRACT 2 – Paving approximately 1.0-mile road length with 2.5” Hot Mix. Work shall be completed in summer of 2023.

There will be a mandatory pre-bid conference on September 7th, 2022, Tue at 2:00pm Local Time at the intersection of Cloverdale Rd & N Hill Rd. Contractors will meet with the Town Board and visit the site to become familiar with the general site conditions that may affect cost, progress and performance of the work.

Bids must be accompanied by bid security in the form of a certified check or bid bond equal to five percent (5%) of the maximum bid price, payable to the Owner as a guaranty that if the Bid is accepted, the Bidder will execute the Contract Documents and furnish the required contract security. If the Successful Bidder fails to execute the Contract Documents and provide the required contract security within 15 days after the Notice of Award, the Owner may annul the Notice of Award and the Bid Security will be forfeited.
